## Area 56 News Mini-Conference Agenda Preview

The agenda items for the upcoming Area 56 Mini Conference have been made available. Some items of particular interest to our Delegate Garwood F. from the Literature Committee are as follows:

- Consider updating the pamphlet "A.A. for the Woman"
- Consider developing literature for the alcoholic with mental health issues. (This topic was proposed by Area 56, and voted on for inclusion at the Convention)
- Consider producing a book combining Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions with the Twelve Concepts for World Service.
- Consider updating the pamphlet "A.A. and the Gay/Lesbian Alcoholic."

Actions taken during the break-out sessions at the Area 56 Mini-Conference are for groups to review, discuss or consider their committee's topics. Those in attendance are given a folder of background information and receive a random committee assignment. After participating in the break-out session discussion and taking part in expressing opinions and coming to a group decision, the information coming out of the committee goes to the floor as everyone re-gathers with their various topics. All those present then hear what each committee has decided and discussed. Everyone has an opportunity to participate, express opinions and follow up with the decision making process. One of the interesting aspects of this process is the opportunity to have the minority opinion heard and see opinions change.
