



NIGHT OWL VOLUNTEERS NEEDED



WHAT IS NIGHT OWL?

Night Owl is a voluntary after-hours phone answering service performed by members of the local AA community. After the Central Office is closed, the phone is forwarded to the home of the volunteer and he/she answers the incoming phone calls from people requesting help or information about AA.

HOW OFTEN AM I SCHEDULED?

We are trying to only schedule each volunteer for a single shift each month. A "shift" is from 4-8 hrs long, depending on the time of day, and we make every attempt possible to assign a time that works around your everyday schedule.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

We are looking for members with a minimum of 1 year continuous sobriety, a telephone, and the ability to commit to 1 shift per month. There is also a brief training program required, which is conducted at the Central Office at your convenience.
